From Linz, it goes by rail to Rheinkamp (near Duisburg). In our well-connected transhipment hub in the Ruhr area, it is possible to add wagons to the train bound for Malmö. From here, further distribution takes place in the single-wagon network for the entire Scandinavian region.
