## Uninterrupted transport of freight trains between Europe and Asia

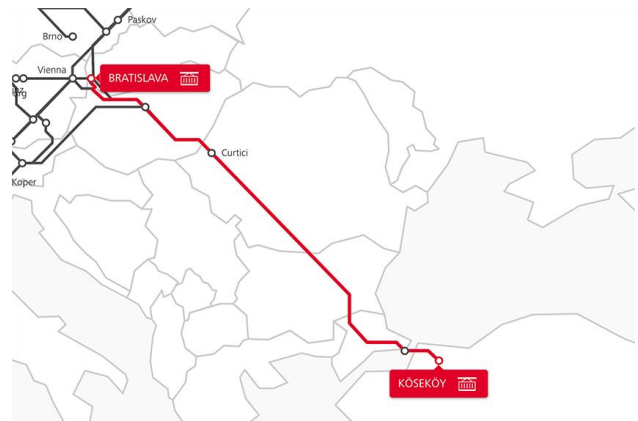
43 kilometres railway route on the Asian side of Turkey and 19 kilometres on the European side are connected by the 14 kilometres long **Marmaray Tunnel** under the Bosphorus. In addition to public, national and international transport, the 76 kilometres long route in the greater Istanbul area also carries freight traffic at night. **Freight trains** free of dangerous goods\* run between the continents between 01:00 a.m. and 05:00 a.m. when the commuter services do not operate.

### TransFER Bratislava–Köseköy

The TransFER Bratislava–Köseköy operates two weekly round trips between Turkey and Slovakia with an attractive transit time of just under six days.
